- 1984** Completed marketing research for the Institution of National Research Agronomical and the Champagne industry.
- 1984-1986** Oenologist for Champagne Deutz and Winemaker in Loire Valley for Societe Viticole du Domaine de l'Aulee / Azay le Rideau.
- 1984-1986** Consultant to Deutz & Gelderman in Breisach am Rhine, Germany.
- 1984** Begins 4 years of consultant work for Navarro Coreas, Mendoza, Argentina.
- 1984-1986** Consultant to Delas Winery in the Northern Rhone.
- 1986** Beringer becomes managing partner of Mason Deutz and Christian joins the Beringer senior winemaking team.
- 1986-1995** Moved to California to become winemaker at Maison Deutz Winery in Arroyo Grande.
